



PRSJ ASCM 2027 Fred Cristaudo Scholarship Application

The Fred Cristaudo Scholarship has been created to encourage students to pursue higher education towards furthering their career in Supply Chain Management. The yearly Scholarship, a total award of \$2500, will be presented to two students (2 @ \$1250) and can go to any educational expenses; including books & supplies and not restricted to tuition only. **The winners of the Scholarship will be selected by the PRSJ Princeton South Jersey ASCM Board of Directors and the award will be announced on June 9, 2027.**

Submission Criteria:

- Each applicant must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in or related to Supply Chain Management, Logistics, or Transportation and reside in the counties under ASCM PRSJ purview.
- Must be a full-time student enrolled at an accredited college, university with a graduation date of 2027 or later.
- Must be a student member of PRSJ ASCM supported chapters (Rider or Rowan University) (can register through apics.org for free).
- Applicant must complete the PRSJ ASCM Supply Chain Scholarship application.
- Must submit a copy of student resume.
- Minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Must attach the most recent school transcript.
- Must submit a one-page essay – topic: **“Your supply chain journey/goals”**.
- Faculty member must submit one letter of recommendation directly to Evp@prsj.ascm.org and studentchapters@prsj.ascm.org
